

Since 2008, we have been helping low-income, disabled, homeless, and families at risk of becoming homeless to obtain the safety and security of the most basic human necessity. Working with a wide variety of community resources and social service agencies, we help those Yuba, Sutter, and Colusa County families to secure housing by assisting with a rental deposit and/or a first month's rent and landlord incentives. The funds we provide go directly to the landlord or property owner. With this helping hand, these families are able to have a place to call home.

Our **Program Administrator** assists clients in assembling the documents for their application and sets a date and time for an interview by a **Board Member** or **Volunteer**. When the interview is completed, and housing has been located, the file will be reviewed by the **Board** for approval and appropriate funding. Our **Housing Navigator** will guide clients as they locate a suitable residence.



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
